OVERVIEW

For those students who are self-supporting and have been having financial difficulties because of the spread of coronavirus, you can apply for STUDENT URGENT SUPPORT BENEFIT in order for you to continue your study and research in this university.

AMOUNT

Resident tax-exempt household: 200,000JPY/person Others: 100,000JPY/person

WHO CAN APPLY

For international students, MUST meet the all criteria below. (1-5&7)

Self-supporting and pay for tuition from your part-time job salary

- (1)No remittance from your family in your home country \rightarrow Remittance less than 1,500,000JPY/year (including tuition)
- (2)As a general rule, you are not living with your family \rightarrow You are making your own living and pay for rent.
- ③Cost of living and tuition and fees are the main expenses of your part-time job wages
- (4) Because of financial difficulties/decrease in income of your family, either parents of yours, you can't expect an additional support from your family.

Your earnings have dropped drastically because of the spread of coronavirus

⁽⁵⁾You have experienced major decrease (50% drop compared with the last month) in your part-time job wages (including financial aid from employment adjustment subsidy) because of the spread of COVID-19.

- 1) Your last year's grade, GPA calculated by JASSO system, must be above 2.3 point.
- 2) Your class attendance is over 80%.
- 3) Remittance is less than 90,000JPY/month (not including entrance fee tuition and fees).
- 4) Your dependent's income is less than 5,000,000JPY.
