[Measures of Restriction on Activities on Campus (except the University Hospital)]

- 1. Starting Date: July 1 (Wed.), 2020
- 2. Level for Restriction on Activities on Campus: Level 1
- 3. Contents of Restrictions:

Entering the Campus: You must pay due attention to prevent the spread of infection, such as avoiding "Three Cs":

- 1. Closed spaces with poor ventilation
- 2. Crowded places with many people nearby
- 3. Close-contact settings such as close-range conversations

Lectures and Practical Classes: <u>In principle, online lectures will be provided. If preventive measures against the spread of infection are taken, it is possible to provide face-to-face lectures.</u>

When your lectures will be face-to-face, you will be notified through Academic Information System (such as Syllabus) and/or from the faculty member in charge. Please check information frequently.

Club/Circle Activities: Activities must be reported in advance.

*Activities (including meetings) must be implemented after taking preventive measures against the spread of infection and under the supervision of the advisor (or after obtaining permission).

Research Activities: Must be implemented after taking preventive measures against the spread of infection

Others: As follows

* Please pay careful attention to the cooperation requests from the government and Okinawa Prefecture, to the "New Lifestyle" indicated by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, and to "Campus Advisory for COVID-19" issued by the University.
