1. Starting Date: Starting on September 23 (Wed.), 2020

- 2. Level for Restriction on Activities on Campus: Level 2
- 3. Contents of Restrictions:

Entering the Campus:

Permitted to enter the campus, while paying due attention to prevention of the spread of infection, such as avoiding "Thee Cs":

1. Closed spaces with poor ventilation

- 2. Crowded places with many people nearby
- 3. Close-contact settings such as close-range conversations

Lectures and Practical Classes:

Only when permitted by the head of Faculty/Center, it is possible to provide face-to-face lectures after taking preventive measures against the spread of infection. In other cases, online lectures will be provided.

* How lectures are going to be provided will be informed through Academic Information System (such as Syllabus) and/or notices from lecturers in charge. Please check information frequently.

Club/Circle Activities:

Circle/club activities must be implemented after reporting the activities.

X Activities (including meetings) must be implemented after taking preventive measures against the spread of infection and under the supervision of the advisor (or after obtaining permission).

Research Activities:

Must be implemented after taking preventive measures against the spread of infection

Others: Matters to be considered are as follows:

X Please pay careful attention to requests for voluntary restraint and cooperation from Okinawa Prefecture to residents, the examples of practicing "New Lifestyle" provided by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, and "Campus Advisory for DOVID-19" issued by the University.
